### GAME NOTES

#### UCF-USF Series Information

- UCF and the Bulls will be meeting for the third-consecutive season
- On Dec. 6, 2008, Jermaine Taylor recorded 30 points as UCF beat USF for the first time since 1994, posting a 71-63 win over the Bulls before 6,695 fans at the UCF Arena
- The Knights limited USF to just six points in the final 10 minutes of the game
- Dominique Jones paced the Bulls with 31 points
- USF has an 18-5 edge in the all-time series
- The Bulls have a 9-2 advantage against the Knights in Tampa
- In the program's last matchup in Tampa, USF held on for a 75-67 win over the Knights on Dec. 1, 2007
- Taylor led UCF with 20 points, but Jones scored 30 points to lead the Bulls to the victory

#### Conference Call

- The game at USF is one of three during December at BIG EAST programs for UCF
- The Knights' next game is Sunday at No. 14 Connecticut
- On Dec. 6, UCF battled host Notre Dame - the score was tied at 41 at halftime - before falling 90-72
- UCF has now faced at least one BIG EAST program in three-straight years

#### Connections

- UCF assistant Robert McCullum, who is in his first year with the Knights, served as USF's head coach from 2003-07
- During his tenure in Tampa, the Bulls recorded four victories over nationally-ranked teams
- UCF has two players from the Tampa area on its roster - Ben O'Donnell (Largo) and A.J. Tyler (Palm Harbor)

#### Up Next for the Knights

- UCF will leave Florida for the second time this season when the Knights meet 14th-ranked Connecticut Sunday in Hartford

#### Last Time Out

- A.J. Tyler totaled a game-high 18 points to lift UCF to a 63-50 win over Bethune-Cookman Saturday at the UCF Arena
- UCF limited the Wildcats to just three points the final five minutes of the game

#### Big Wins to Start the Year

- UCF has started the campaign with several big wins, highlighted by triumphs over Auburn, Drake and Massachusetts
- Both Auburn (NIT) and Drake (CollegelInsider.com) participated in the postseason a year ago

#### Tough Slate

- Despite having one of the nation's youngest teams, UCF is facing the toughest non-league schedule in program history
- The slate includes contests at three BIG EAST programs, plus two games (vs. Auburn, at Ole Miss) against SEC squads
- Eight of UCF's non-conference foes played in the postseason last spring

#### Show and Improve

- Despite facing a difficult schedule, the Knights are off to a 7-2 start in 2009-10
- UCF was 5-4 last season after nine games

#### Approaching History

- In his 17th year with the Knights, Kirk Speraw has 271 victories at UCF and needs only four to become the winningest coach in program history
- Torchy Clark, who coached the Knights from 1969-83, won 274 games in Orlando
- The 2006-07 Conference USA Coach of the Year, Speraw has led the Knights to the NCAA Tournament on four occasions
- He is one of only 14 coaches in the country who have spent at least 16-straight years at their current school

#### New Balance

- Last year, Jermaine Taylor averaged 26.2 points and led the Knights in scoring in 29 of the team's 31 games
- The All-America selection finished the campaign third nationally in scoring and was one of three UCF players (Isaac Sosa, A.J. Tyler) to pace the squad in points
- With Taylor playing in the NBA, UCF now features a more balanced offense
- Through nine games in 2009-10, five Knights have already led the team in points - Tyler (4), Sosa (2), Keith Clanton, Dave Diakite and Taylor Young
- Six UCF players are averaging at least 7.0 points an outing, and the team's leading scorer is Isaac Sosa (12.3)

#### Big Three

- One of the best shooters on the team, A.J. Tyler surprisingly shot just 39.6 percent overall as he averaged 9.3 points in UCF's first six games of the year
- Thankfully for the Knights, Tyler has gotten back on track and has averaged 15.7 points on 56.8 percent shooting from the floor in UCF's last three games
- The junior has scored in double-figures in each of UCF's last three contests and is averaging 11.4 points on the year

#### Getting to the Point

- Despite his diminutive stature, Chicago native A.J. Rompza is UCF's leader on and off the floor
- Rompza was a Conference USA All-Freshman Team pick a year ago after averaging 5.2 assists
- His main job was to get the ball to league player of the year Jermaine Taylor, who averaged 26.2 points

- As a result, Rompza averaged just 4.3 points per game
- Without Taylor, the point guard is looking to score more this season and is averaging 8.7 points an outing
- Rompza matched a career-high with 13 points at Notre Dame on Dec. 6, and has averaged 10.7 points in the Knights' last three games

### Rompza Steals

- A.J. Rompza ranks third nationally in steals, averaging 3.3 per game
- He has recorded five steals in each of UCF's last three contests
- The sophomore grabbed 46 steals in 29 games last year, and already has 30 swipes in 2009-10

### Head Start

- Keith Clanton made the first start of his young career versus Bethune-Cookman Saturday, and totaled nine points, five rebounds, four blocks and two assists in 23 minutes
- The Orlando native paces UCF on the boards (6.7) and is third in scoring at 9.1 points per game
- Clanton is shooting 59.6 percent from the field
- The freshman had his best game of the year at Notre Dame on Dec. 6, totaling 14 points on 5-of-8 shooting and a team-best seven rebounds in 28 minutes

### Swat Team

- A year ago, guard Jermaine Taylor led the Knights with 24 blocked shots
- In just nine games this season, Keith Clanton has already registered 18 swats

### Getting Defensive

- When the Knights held Bethune-Cookman to only 50 points last Saturday, it marked the second time this season that a UCF opponent was limited to 50 points (Drake, Nov. 22)
- This season, foes are averaging 65.2 points versus the Knights
- Through nine games last year, UCF's opponents were averaging 70.6 points
- The Knights rank second in Conference USA and 33rd nationally, as their foes are shooting just 28.2 percent from 3-point range

### Minute By Minute

- No UCF player is averaging more than 30.0 minutes a contest
- A.J. Rompza is logging the most time for the Knights, averaging 29.1 minutes

### Winning Without the Three

- Last year, UCF attempted 20.5 3-point field goals per game
- In 2009-10, the Knights are relying less on the three-ball, and having more success in the win-loss column
- Through nine contests, the team is attempting 14.2 treys per game

### Halfway House

- UCF is 6-0 when leading at halftime this season
- Last year, the Knights were 10-3 when leading at intermission

### Hey Young World

- With only three upperclassmen (one senior, two juniors) and 12 underclassmen, UCF is one of the youngest squads in the country in 2009-10

• The Knights have the fourth-fewest amount of upperclassmen in the country:

### The Youngsters

- Through nine games this year, UCF's underclassmen are responsible for 72.2 percent of the team's points
- Freshmen and sophomores have logged 74.6 percent of the squad's minutes

### Rated Rookies

- UCF's freshman class of Keith Clanton, Marcus Jordan and R.J. Scott is considered to be one of the top recruiting classes in the country
- The group was listed as the seventh-best "non-BCS" recruiting class in the country by ESPN.com and was named one of the 50-best classes by *Prep Stars Recruiters Handbook*
- Clanton finished his senior year as the 68th-best senior in the country according to Rivals.com
- HoopScoop named Jordan the country's 115th-best player

### Facing the Best

- This past summer, Isaac Sosa worked hard on his game when he helped Puerto Rico place sixth out of 16 teams at the FIBA U19 World Championship in New Zealand
- Sosa averaged 9.6 points in nine games and connected on 18-of-39 attempts from 3-point range
- Playing against the best young talent in the world has paid off for Sosa
- Through nine games, he is averaging a team-high 12.3 points for the Knights
- As a freshman, he made eight starts and averaged 8.2 points during the season

### Going Deep

- He might not get much recognition nationally, but Isaac Sosa is one of the premier 3-point shooters in the country
- This season, Sosa leads in Conference USA and is 13th nationally, shooting 50.0 percent (24-of-48) from deep
- For his career, the sophomore has made 81-of-174 attempts from 3-point range
- His career 3-point field goal percentage (46.6) ranks second all-time at UCF (Edsel Bester, 47.4) and is tied for first in C-USA history

### Welcome to the Show

- A year ago, Dave Diakite appeared in only five games at the start of the campaign before suffering a season-ending knee injury
- The redshirt freshman is now healthy, and is off to a strong start this season
- The small forward is averaging 7.7 points and is second on the team in rebounds per game (6.1)
- Diakite has already recorded a pair of double-doubles

### The Score

- A year ago, Taylor Young spent time at both guard spots, but his primary role was to distribute the ball
- The Orlando native averaged 3.4 assists and 3.3 points
- The junior worked on his offensive game over the summer, and the results have shown
- He is averaging 7.8 points in 2009-10
- Young has scored in double-figures on four occasions
- He entered the campaign having scored at least 10 points in a game only twice during his career

### A Big-Time University

- When Kirk Speraw was hired as UCF's head coach in 1993, the school's enrollment was listed at 23,000
- Today, UCF is the third-largest university in the nation with 53,537 students
- Only Arizona State (55,552) and Ohio State (55,014) have higher enrollments
